Registrar's Report to CDSS Council – October 2022

I am pleased to provide my report to CDSS Council.

Update on Regulatory Bylaw Revisions

We have met with the Ministry on the ongoing revisions and they have provided more comments to be incorporated into the draft and a new side-by-side. We anticipate this being done by end of January 2023 but we have to wait for the Ministry analyst to return from holidays.

Sedation Standard

Some feedback on the process of getting people their permits for sedation.

- 1. Registrants are confused that they are permitted to do sedation but that they don't receive a paper permit.
- 2. It would be useful to have an FAQ specifying in plain language what the requirements are for:
 - a. registrants registering for the first time for a particular level of sedation.
 - b. registrants re-registering for the same level of sedation

Changes to Licensure

1. We need to revise our licensing registrant form and the wording for the Authorized Practice Director concept as registrants still are confused as to what to write.

2. We have submitted a proposed revision of our licensing categories to provide options for some practitioners who license later in the year via a three-stage proration system. This will apply to first licenses and renewals.
