Dear Ashley Stevens,

On behalf of The College of Dental Surgeons of Saskatchewan (CDSS), and in response to a concern from a member of the public to a CDSS registrant, I would like to inquire into what the Denturist Society of Saskatchewan's defines as a "removable dental prosthesis."

The Dental Disciplines Act (DDA) section 23(3) outlines that Denturists are able "[...] to make, repair, reline, alter, replace or furnish a removable dental prosthesis, and for that purpose carry out non-surgical intraoral procedures, including the taking of impressions that are necessary to make, repair, reline, alter, replace or furnish a removable dental prosthesis." The College of Dental Surgeons would like to inquire about the removable prosthesis definition currently in use by the Denturists of Saskatchewan.
